

ADULT FAMILY HOME TRAINING NETWORK

Supporting Medicaid-contracted adult family homes in recruiting, training, and retaining long-term care workers.

Training Programs Covered

Eligible adult family homes can sponsor caregivers for:

- Home Care Aide (HCA) 75-hour training (may qualify for stipend)
- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA/NAC) 108-hour training (may qualify for stipend)
- HCA to CNA Bridge Program (must have active HCA license)
- Adult Family Home Administrator Training (must meet WAC 388-76-10130)
- HCA Pre-Prometric Test Refresher

- Nurse Delegation with a Special Focus on Diabetes
