

GET INVOLVED IN A PROJECT USING A VIRTUAL REALITY SYSTEM FOR ADULT FAMILY HOME CAREGIVER TRAINING



WHO?

We are inviting you to participate in our research project if you:

- Are 18 years of age or older,
- Are working at an adult family home in Washington State,
- Are a CNA or HCA, or have completed CNA or HCA certification training but not yet certified
- Have at least one month of caregiving experience in an adult family home, AND
- Understand and speak English

WHY?

- The caregiver's training, health, and safety are critical to resident care.
- Current training is generalized, and skills practice is not in real-world settings. Also, the caregiver courses fall short on addressing the adult family home workforce's health and safety.
- We plan to develop a new interactive virtual reality program that mimics adult family homes for caregiver training.
- Your experience will help us decide what to put in the content and scenarios.

WHAT IF YOU MEET THOSE CRITERIA AND AGREE TO PARTICIPATE?

Our interviewer will schedule a time to talk with you. The interview will:

- Be about 90 minutes
- Be done via Zoom (audio/videoconferencing tool)
- Be scheduled for a time that is easy for you
